

Rulemaking notice from the Minnesota Department of Labor and Industry

This special edition of *COMPACT* explains the Department of Labor and Industry's intention to amend rules governing workers' compensation treatment parameters for the relief of injured workers' intractable pain using spinal cord stimulators and intrathecal drug delivery systems in Minnesota Rules, chapter 5221.
