**Question:** Does "building supply," as defined by the Minnesota Plumbing Code, end after any central water conditioning or treatment equipment and/or after the last pressure tank prior to the piping that takes water to water heaters, fixtures or other water outlets, thus allowing the use of PVC pipe and fittings for water conditioning and treatment equipment and cold-water atmospheric storage tanks?

Answer: No.

Analysis: Building Supply, as defined in section 204.0, ends after a water meter, pressure tank, or other point of use or distribution on the lot, whichever comes first.

**Commentary:** This request for interpretation was received on or about April 7, 2025. It was considered by the Minnesota Plumbing Board on April 15, 2025. All parties had an opportunity to be heard. As required by Minnesota Statutes, section 326B.127, subd. 5, the Minnesota Plumbing Board will consider this final interpretation for adoption as part of the Minnesota Plumbing Code.
