

Step-by-step instructions to using PC Pricer tool

For discharge dates: May 31 through Sept. 30, 2017

Download the PC Pricer tool from the following .zip file (22MB): [PC Pricer tool -- 2016.1](#). The file contains four documents:

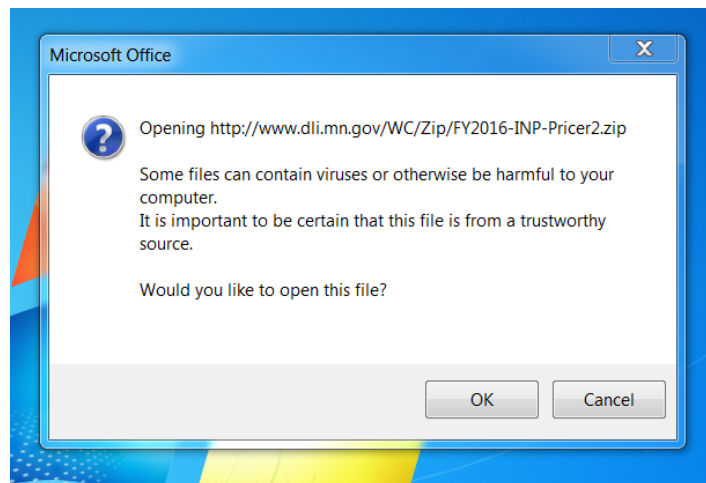
- a Microsoft word document describing changes to the Pricer;
- a text file describing the same changes;
- the FujitsuNetCOBOL application; and
- the PC Pricer tool effective Jan. 19, 2016, labeled as ZZ_INP1611601V1.

System requirements

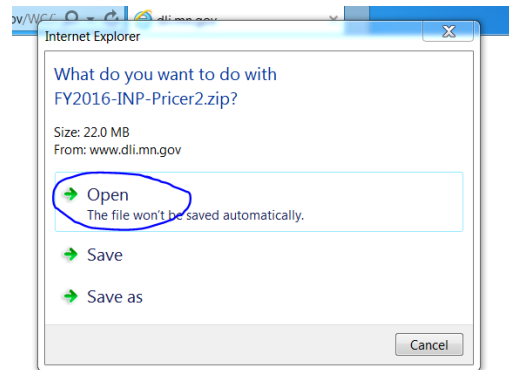
The PC Pricer can only be installed on the Microsoft Windows operating system.

Installation steps

1. Click on the link to the .zip file linked above and on www.dli.mn.gov/WC/PcPricer.asp.
2. A window will pop up. Click "OK."



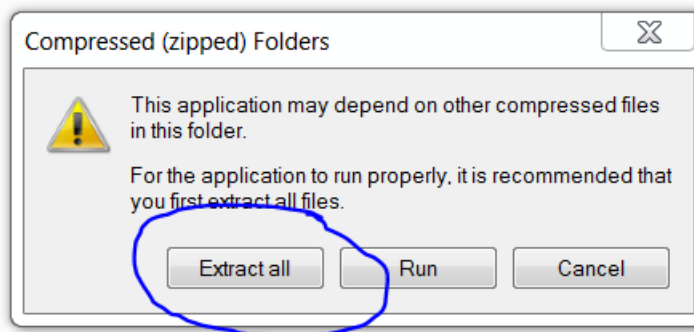
3. A new window will pop up. Click “Open” or click “Save” if you would like to keep the file.



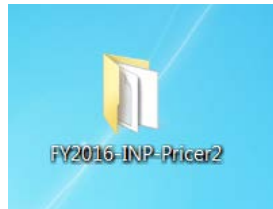
4. The .zip file, with the four documents listed above, will open on your computer. Click on the FujitsuNetCOBOL application. A one-time installation of Fujitsu NetCOBOL run time files is required. You should not have to repeat this step if you have already installed these run files previously.

5. A new window will pop up. Click “Extract all.” Select your desktop or another preferred destination for the files.



6. A file download box will not appear after installation, but a new “FY2016-INP-Pricer2” folder should appear on your desktop. Open this folder.



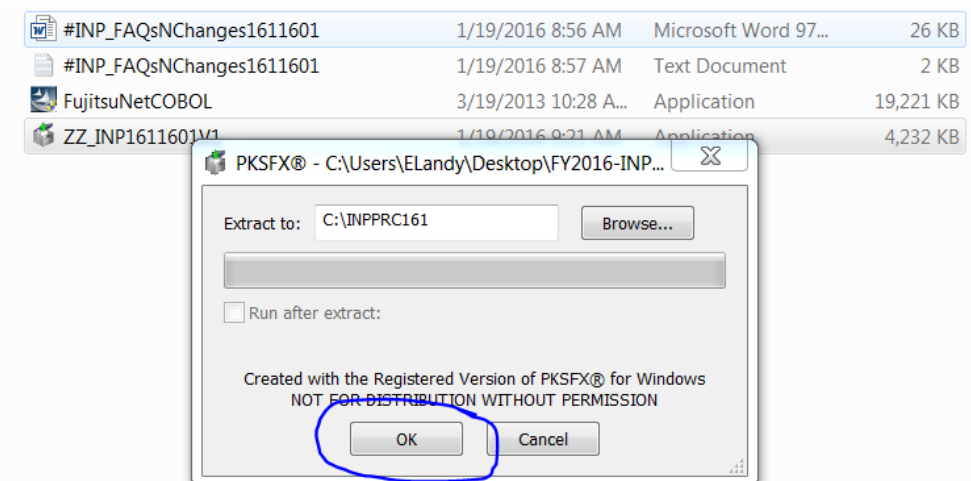
7. The new folder contains the extracted versions of the four documents in the .zip file. Double-click on the “FujitsuNetCOBOL” program.

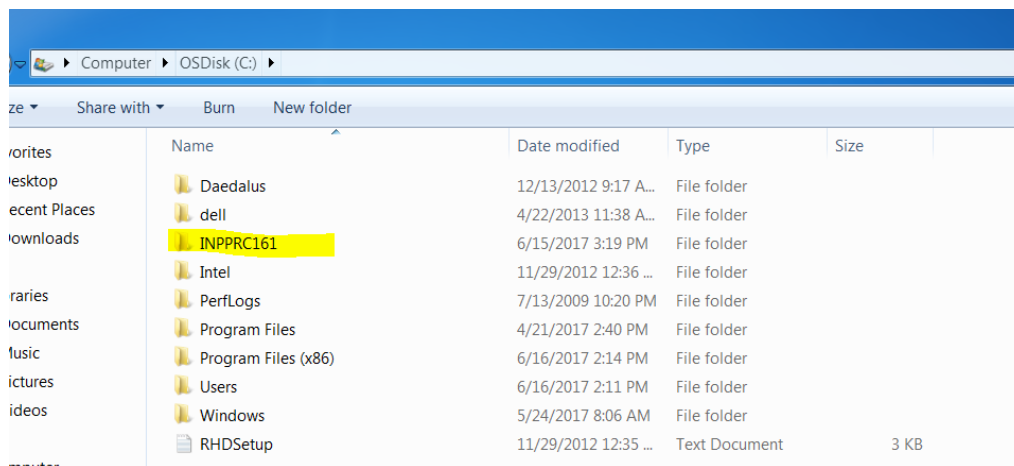
8. In the same folder, double-click on the “ZZ_INP161101V1” application file.

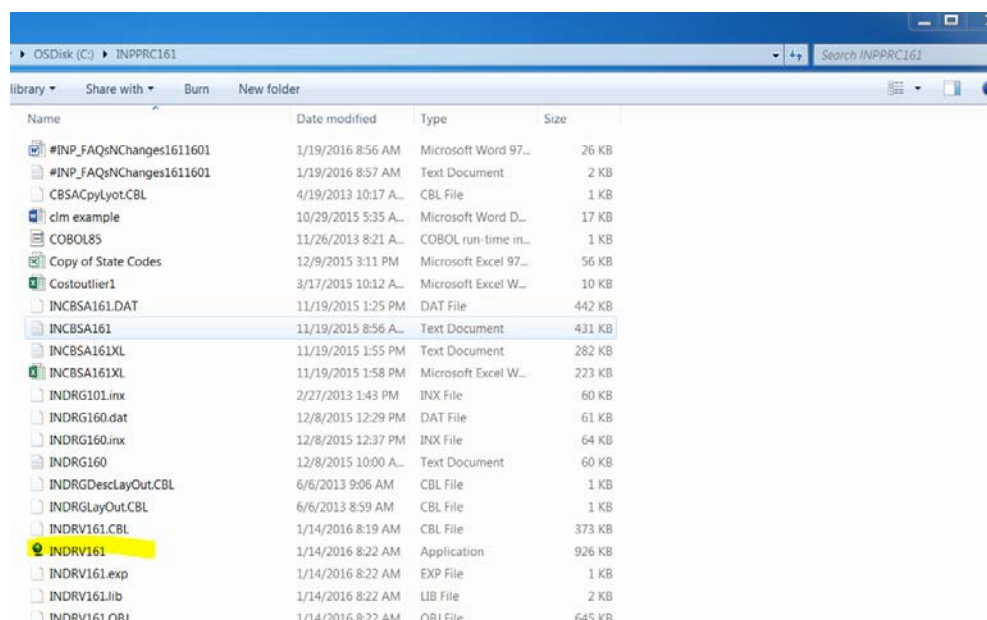
9. A window will appear to download the PC Pricer file to your computer. You will need to choose what drive you extract the file to on your computer – the first letter in the “Extract to:” box (below, it is saved to a C: drive (hard drive)). Do not change anything else in this box. Click “OK.”



10. On your computer, wherever you saved the file, open the “INPPRC161” folder.



11. Among the items in this folder is a single application file – “INDRV161.” This is the PC Pricer tool. Double-click on this application file to open the PC Pricer.
