4. Department of Labor and Industry Greetings and Update

Kate Perushek, Deputy Commissioner, Minnesota Department of Labor and Industry

- Deputy Commissioner Perushek shared updates on DLI's legislative proposals related to apprenticeship, including:
 - Safe and skilled workforce bill (SF10) continues to make its way through the legislative process.
 - The policy proposal to formally establish a Division of Apprenticeship continues to move through the legislative process.
 - The budget proposal to expand the Labor Education Advancement Program (LEAP) grant from \$100,000 annually to \$1 million annually and to broaden eligibility to include women, people of color, non-profits, and tribal governments continues to move through the legislative process.
 - The budget proposal to provide apprenticeship sponsors with funding to purchase equipment to train
 journeyworkers and apprentices in clean economy occupations and skills continues to move through the
 legislative process.
 - DLI is also following budget proposals related to early childhood educator and community health center registered apprenticeship programs.

 2023.
