Arrowhead Economic Opportunity Agency

The [Arrowhead Economic Opportunity Agency](#) (AEOA) was incorporated in April 1965 as a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization and established as a Community Action Program (CAP) for the northeast Minnesota counties of St. Louis, Lake and Cook in response to the 1964 Economic Opportunity Act. AEOA offers services in these counties and the nine neighboring counties of Aitkin, Carlton, Cass, Chisago, Crow Wing, Isanti, Itasca, Koochiching and Pine making it one of the largest private, non-profit Community Action Agencies in Minnesota.

Graduates will earn industry credentials in new trades/careers, with course lengths ranging from four weeks to six or more months, depending on the program. Career training programs/trade school programs are available for no cost for individuals who meet eligibility requirements. Some programs include paid training, and all participants are assisted by Avivo's career counselors for job placement
