(5) Epidural injections:

- (a) time for treatment response, within one two weeks;
- (b) maximum treatment frequency, once every two weeks if a positive response to the first injection. If subsequent injections at any one site demonstrate diminishing control of symptoms or fail to facilitate objective functional gains functionality, then injections should be discontinued at that site. Only one injection is reimbursable No more than two levels may be injected per patient visit; and
- (c) maximum treatment, three <u>four</u> injections <u>visits</u>, in a 12-month period. <u>Each visit may include injections at one or two levels</u>.
