

PRIVACY NOTICE

CHALLENGE TO OUTCOME OF COMBATIVE SPORT CONTEST UNDER MINNESOTA STATUTES SECTION 341.345

1. The information you provide to the Minnesota Office of Combative Sports and the Minnesota Department of Labor and Industry (“OCS”) in connection to the challenge of the outcome of a combative sport contest under Minnesota Statutes section 341.345 may be considered private or confidential under the Minnesota Government Data Practices Act. Minnesota Statutes section 13.04, subdivision 2 requires that we notify you of the following before you supply any private or confidential information about yourself in response to the request that will be considered by the OCS.
2. This information is being collected as part of an investigation into whether the outcome of a combative sport contest should be changed, and the information you supply to OCS may be used to make that determination.
3. You are not required to supply any data in connection to the challenge of the outcome of a combative sport contest.
4. If you supply the information in connection to the challenge of the outcome of a combative sport contest, OCS may use it to determine whether the result of a combative sports contest should be changed. If you supply the information requested and it shows a violation of any of the statutes or rules enforced or administered by OCS, then you may be subject to enforcement action by the Department, including an action against your license, if any, and the assessment of monetary penalties.
5. If you do not supply information to OCS, OCS may base its decision on information available from other sources.
6. The information you supply will be accessible to OCS staff, and the Office of the Minnesota Attorney General. It may be released to other persons and/or governmental entities who have statutory authority to review the information, investigate specific conduct and/or take appropriate legal action, including but not limited to law enforcement agencies, courts, the state auditor, the legislative auditor, and other regulatory agencies. It may also be shared upon court order. In addition, your name and the information you supply could become public data.
