### Worksheet and Code Change Proposal Review:

The TAG reviewed chapter 3 worksheet items 71 through 139 corresponding to sections R302.6 through R311.3.2

- 71. <u>Table R302.6</u> There is a current Minnesota amendment to this table. A TAG member will submit a CCP for this section.
- 95. <u>R309, R309.1</u> The TAG consensus is to accept the model code language with a modification to maintain the existing exception for 2-unit townhouses in Minnesota Rules.
- 96. <u>R309.1.1</u> The TAG consensus is to accept the model code language and delete the current Minnesota amendment.
- 97. <u>R309.2</u> The TAG consensus is to modify the model code language to maintain the current Minnesota amendment.
- 98. <u>R309.2.1</u> Accept the model code language as written. MN amend not needed due to model code text changes.
