

MUNICIPAL FEE AND EXPENSE REPORT

Minnesota Department of Labor and Industry

What is a Municipal Fee and Expense Report?

A Municipal Fee and Expense Report is the documentation of all construction and development-related fees and expenses collected by a municipality from contractors, subcontractors, owners and developers when the cumulative fees collected exceed \$5,000 in the reporting year. The report is required by [Minnesota Statute 326B.145](#).

What is the purpose of the report?

The purpose of the report is to provide public transparency of the revenue collected and expenses incurred in providing municipal building code enforcement and development review/approvals.

Who is required to submit the report?

All municipalities that adopt and enforce the State Building Code, regardless of population, are required to complete and submit a Municipal Fee and Expense Report to the Minnesota Department of Labor and Industry (DLI).

What must be reported?

The report must include:

1. The number and valuation of permits and building types for which fees were paid.
2. The amount of fees paid for permits, plan review, administrative, engineering, infrastructure and other construction and development-related work.
3. The expenses associated with the municipal activities for which fees were collected.

When is the report due?

Municipalities must file a Municipal Fee and Expense Report each year by June 30 for the preceding calendar year.
