

Roseville contractor fined \$15k for unlicensed work

- A Roseville contractor was found to have performed plumbing, electric and remodeling work without having the required contractor licenses and bonding. The contractor was ordered to cease and desist from the unlicensed activities and fined \$15,000.
- A Thief River Falls contractor was found to have violated a previous cease and desist order by continuing to perform unlicensed residential remodeling and roofing work. The contractor was again ordered to cease and desist from the unlicensed activities and fined \$7,500.
- A Maple Grove contractor was found to have performed plumbing, electric, and remodeling work without having the required contractor licenses and bonding. The contractor was ordered to cease and desist from the unlicensed activities and fined \$18,000, of which \$13,000 was stayed contingent on full future compliance.
- A licensed St. Cloud residential building contractor was found to have breached contracts with multiple homeowners by failing to complete projects after receiving payments. The contractor's license was revoked and a \$37,500 fine was assessed, which was entirely stayed contingent on full future compliance.
