Proclamation

- WHEREAS: Minnesota is strengthened by a history of empowered workers acting in solidarity within organized labor and through worker centers; and
- WHEREAS: Minnesota’s economy is built on the foundations of a safe working environment and decent work that pays a fair day’s wage for a fair day’s work; and
- WHEREAS: These foundations for our economy and our communities are protected through regulation, education, engagement, enforcement, and workforce programming; and
- WHEREAS: Minnesotans have a right to healthy and safe working and living environments; and
- WHEREAS: Minnesotans deserve to understand their workplace rights and feel empowered to take action to assert those rights; and,
- WHEREAS: The State of Minnesota is committed to education, engagement, and outreach in partnership with employers, employees, potential employees, community groups, and workers’ rights organizations to ensure workers and employers have a clear understanding of their rights and responsibilities in the workplace.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TIM WALZ, Governor of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of September 21-27, 2025 as:

WORKPLACE RIGHTS WEEK

in the State of Minnesota.
